Course description

The Malta Institute for Medical education are running courses, with faculty provided by the Special Rescue Group, St Lazarus Corps for participants with a 3-year internationally recognised certification. The course teaches First Aiders, Rescuers and First Responders to effectively recognise and treat paediatric emergencies in the critical first minutes until emergency medical services personnel arrive. These courses provide a complete health and safety training solution for first aid, rescue, life saving and domestic situations and is intended for those persons assigned to respond to emergencies in children as well as those who want to learn and be able to be of assistance.

Certification is by assessment.

The **First Aid** and **BLS** course can be run back to back such as over a weekend.

Costings

The full day course will be €40 per person with discount for group bookings.

Equipment and certificates are included.
